



Pollination

Many farms depend on bees. Bees pollinate crops.

This lets those plants produce fruits or seeds.

Pollination is taking pollen from one flower to another flower.



Bees can be moved from one field to another field. They use pollen to produce honey on their hive.


A beekeeper takes care of the bees, moves their hives from field to field and collects honey.




