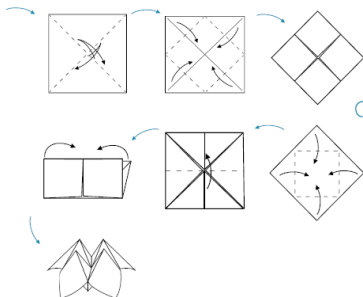
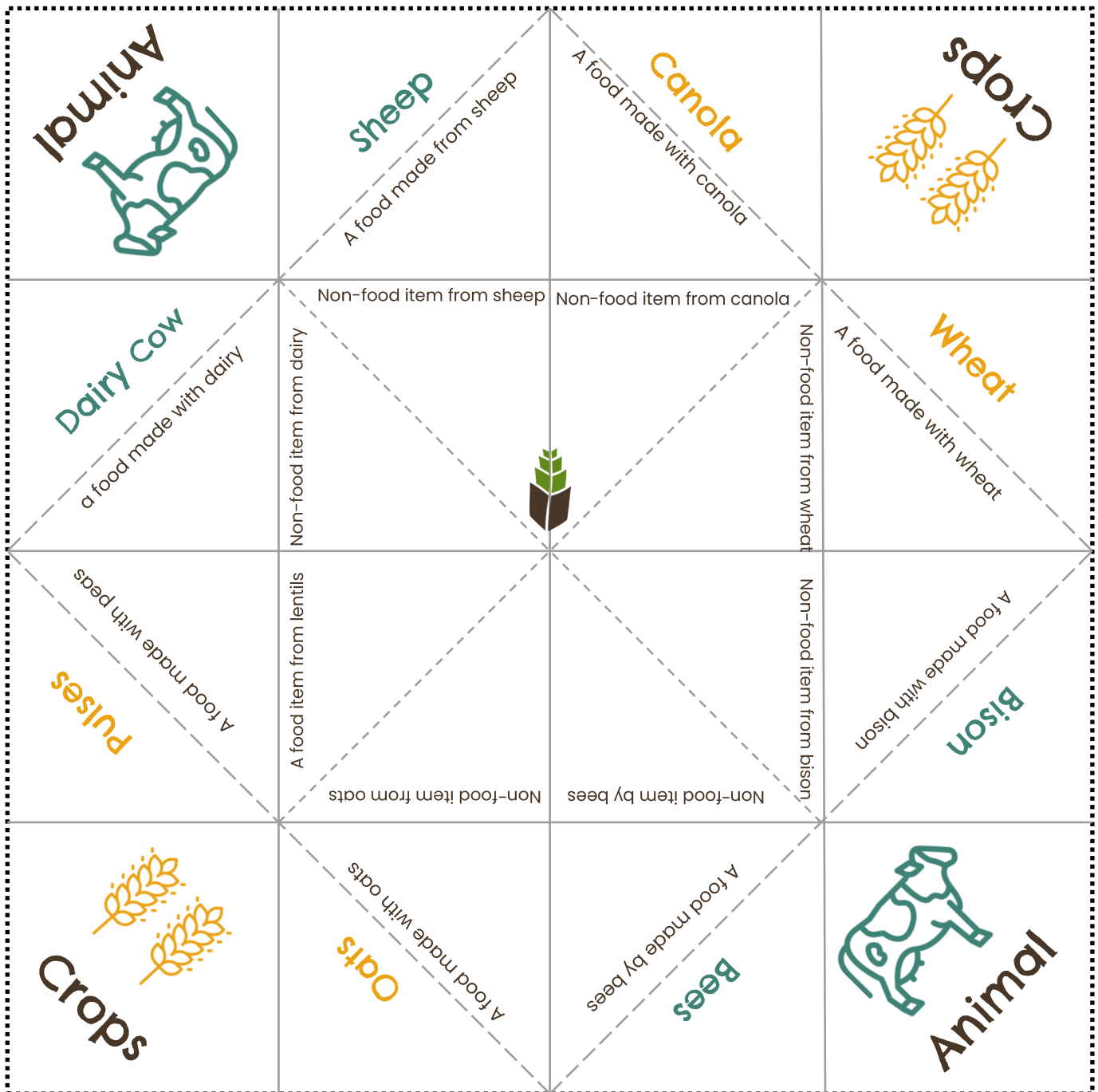


HOW TO MAKE YOUR FORTUNE TELLER

1. Explore the Foundations of Sask Ag e-learning modules to investigate the familiar food and non-food items made using Saskatchewan grown products. <https://aitc.sk.ca/resources/foundations-of-sk-agriculture> Write an item for each prompt in the fortune teller.
2. Cut along the dotted line. Starting with your square facing down, fold and crease on both diagonals, then open the paper.
3. Fold all 4 corners toward the centre so the points meet in the middle.
4. Flip it over so the folded side faces down. Again, fold all 4 corners so the points meet in the middle.
5. Fold the square in half so the 4 main pictures are facing out, unfold, then fold it in half the other way. Now slide your fingers and thumbs under the squares and push the 4 corners into the centre.

Now you're ready to play! With a partner, spell out one of the categories and move your fingers back and forth. Get your partner to pick an inside category and spell it out. Pick a final category and open the flap. Your partner can try to name an item matching the prompt. Did they name the same item as you did?





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
